- Huddle space automation provides built in control functionality with event triggers like turning displays on or off and dimming the lights. This brings a new level of management to the huddle space.
- Make the space intuitive. When users feel comfortable using the tech tools in the huddle space, they will be more empowered to join in the communications, which in turn keeps everyone on task and more attentive.
